

Private Shark Shoot Brief

Staff Responsible	TD designates Divemaster (DM). DM advise time of brief and prepares bait, gloves, hoods etc. Standard fill 210bar, 220 for heavy breathers on this dive.
Max 8 Divers	Photographers with 80+ dives inc. shark dive experience (MBDE OK). Require DSLR or substantial Compact Camera Rig (ie.GoPro shark shield) as shark barrier. Shark shield loaned free of charge in exchange for footage shot.
Fee	\$75p.p. max 8. \$150 if one person.
Dress in Black	Black wetsuit, hood and gloves <u>must</u> be worn.

Start Dive	DM & buddy pairs descend via transit line (dive deck to mooring). DM directs divers to seating positions in amphitheatre. When ready DM directs ½ of group to feed bommie. Position divers on the amphitheatre side of the feed bommie.
Diver Control	The bait crate is fixed to the hollowed area top of bommie at 15m /50ft. Keep crate, ropes etc. out of view Max 4 divers for 10 mins at a time on feed bommie. No one on ocean side! Divers on bommie or amphitheatre maintain position don't fin around.
10min shoot	After 10 mins DM direct team 1 and team 2 to swop positions for 10mins.
2nd Rotation	2 nd rotation of divers. Diver must have 100bar/1500psi remaining. Ascend with buddy along transit line to safety stop BEFORE 50bar/750psi.
Safety	DM continuously monitors shark behaviour & position of divers. Use shark baton to get attention of divers <u>or keep keeps sharks away if necessary.</u> Keep rope & baton out of view.
Finish Dive	DM signals photo shoot complete by crossing arms. Divers must not approach bait bin. Must keep 3 metres away! Divers can continue diving in buddy teams or solo if certified
